This Policy and associated procedures have been developed in accordance with the Work Health and Safety Act 2012 and WorkCover NSW safety guidelines.

### Application of this Policy

This Policy is effective from 1 December 2021 and will operate until replaced.

Port Stephens Netball Association is committed to continuously improving this policy and the associated procedures to reflect changes in legislation. This Policy may be amended from time to time by resolution of the Executive Committee.
